- **There are no garbage bins, so please take your garbage home and dispose of it there.**
- Perform maintenance of the assigned plot. This includes, but is not limited to, planting, watering and weeding. The Garden Committee will assume a neglected plot to be abandoned if it has not been tended within seven days of notification and will be given to another gardener and there will be no refund.
- **Have my garden plot cleaned out by October 15. Any crops left in plot after October 15 may be given to the local Food Bank or tilled into the ground.**
- **You are required to respect all Community Garden guidelines that are provided – failure to conform to this may result in forfeiture of the site (current year) and restriction of access in future years.**
- Be responsible for any non-gardeners accompanying me to the site and ensure children are supervised.

Initial spring tilling will be performed by the middle of May, ground conditions and weather permitting. Everyone will be e-mailed a copy of the map as to your plot(s) location when it is ready for you to plant. If you are unsure where you are to plant, you can contact Kim @ 403-652-8105 or e-mail @ daniellsjake01@gmail.com. **If you do not plant in your designated area, you will get tilled under!** If you had a plot in the previous year, you will be given that same general area plot.
